

Using **Shelterguard** & **Treeguard** **plus** **plus**

For Shrubs

Diameters: 130–160mm, 150–180mm or 170–200mm

Please study this leaflet carefully before using your Guards

Ensure that your trees and shrubs are planted carefully. Use only good quality stock of species suitable to the site. If necessary prune trees to a single leading shoot; shrubs may be cut back to encourage multi stemmed growth. If possible remove roots of perennial weeds, such as nettles, docks, bracken or couch.

Drawings to illustrate techniques are set out overleaf.

Maintenance

Do not neglect plants in Guards. Regular inspection followed by any necessary maintenance is important.

Prevent weed growth within 60cm (2ft) of each Guard most simply by herbicide application. **Failure to control weeds will significantly reduce height growth** and may threaten survival.

Tree stems should split these tubes after a period of stretching once the stems have filled the tubes. However, customers may prefer to remove the tubes at an earlier time. In any case, arrangements should be made for the waste plastic to be collected.

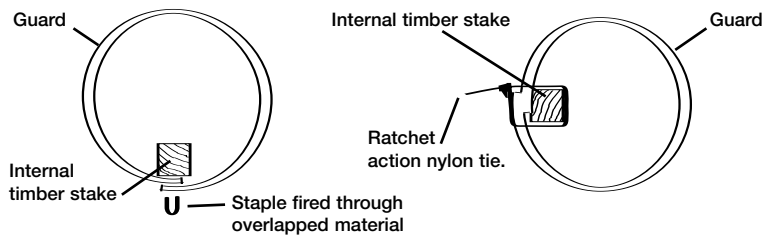
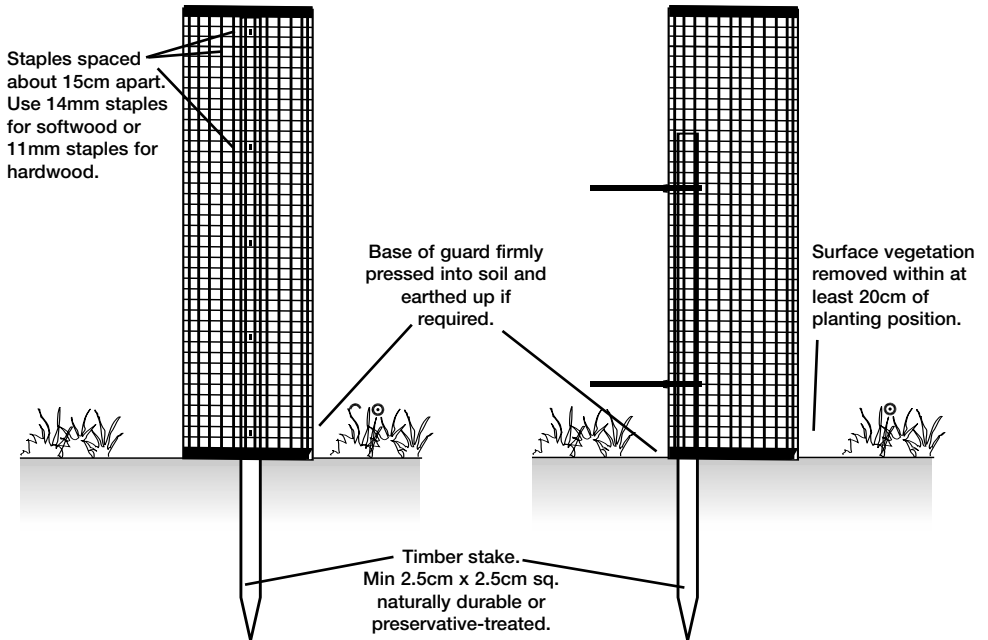

1. In exposed positions a second support may be needed, particularly with the wider diameters.
2. In sheltered positions 2 or 3 internal bamboo canes may provide sufficient support.
